A RESOLUTION STATING OPPOSITION TO CHANGES TO THE ALLEN COUNTY FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX OR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A FORT WAYNE FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX

WHEREAS, the restaurant industry within Allen County is an essential industry and has encountered abundant difficulties due to the impacts of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, a substantial number of Allen County hospitality workers have been involuntarily idled during the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, such difficulties encountered by restaurants, restaurant suppliers and related vendors have resulted in a loss of income which has adversely affected many families; and

WHEREAS, the imposition of a new food and beverage tax will have a dramatic and negative impact on one of the hardest hurt industries; and

WHEREAS, a change in the food and beverage tax statute would chill future investment and slow Allen County's economic recovery from the effects of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Fort Wayne City Council stands with other fiscal bodies of Allen County to oppose any and all efforts by the Indiana General Assembly to allow any local government unit within the County of Allen to adopt an additional food and beverage tax.
