WHEREAS, the appropriation from the 2024 Communications-General Fund budget will be presented to City Council; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

**SECTION 1.** The Consolidated Communications Partnership 2024 budget is approved as described in Exhibit A attached.

**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
