## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2025 BUDGET FOR THE CONSOLIDATED COMMUNICATIONS PARTNERSHIP OF ALLEN COUNTY, INDIANA AND THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE (CCP).

**SECTION 1.** The Consolidated Communications Partnership 2025 budget is approved as described in Exhibit A attached.
