

Wet Weather Ahead

Scattered Flooding Possible Through The Weekend

Key Messages

- Two primary rounds of rain and storms today and tonight. Additional rounds possible late Saturday
 - ◆ Round 1: This morning into early afternoon
 - ◆ Round 2: This evening into the overnight hours
- → Heavy rain and flooding are the main threats, but isolated damaging wind gusts are possible throughout the period
- → Flooding threat will increase with each subsequent round of rain as the ground becomes more saturated

Important Updates/Next Briefing

- → Higher confidence in precipitation timing for today and tonight
- → Next briefing time is Friday afternoon

Rounds 1 & 2



- → Two primary rounds of rain and storms today and tonight.
 - Round 1: This morning into early afternoon
 - Round 2: This evening into the overnight hours
- → Heavy rain, flooding, and damaging wind gusts are the main threats.

Flooding


Scattered Flash Flooding, areal flooding near creeks, rivers, and low lying areas



Damaging Wind

Isolated damaging wind gusts possible through both periods

Total Forecast Rainfall Today into Tonight (in)



→ Flooding threat will increase with each subsequent round of rain as the ground becomes more saturated.





Saturday & Sunday

Additional Potential for Heavy Rain, Flooding, & Isolated Damaging Wind Gusts

Timing (

- Additional chances for showers and storms on Saturday and Sunday.
- Best chances will be Saturday evening. Less confidence on Sunday.

Actions



Be weather aware and ready to act. Have multiple ways to receive warning information!

Scattered Flash Flooding, areal flooding near creeks, rivers, and low lying areas



Damaging Wind

Isolated strong wind gusts possible

Additional Potential Rainfall (in) Saturday into Sunday

What Can You Do to Prepare?

3 SIMPLE STEPS FOR FLASH FLOOD SAFETY

During a flood, water levels and the rate the water is flowing can quickly change. Remain aware and monitor local radio and television.





- Get out of the areas subject to Flooding
- 2 DO NOT DRIVE INTO WATER
 Do NOT drive or walk into
 flooded areas. It only takes 6"
 of water to knock you off your
 feet.
 - STAY INFORMED

 Monitor local radar, television,
 weather radio, internet or
 social media for updates.
