## Key Messages

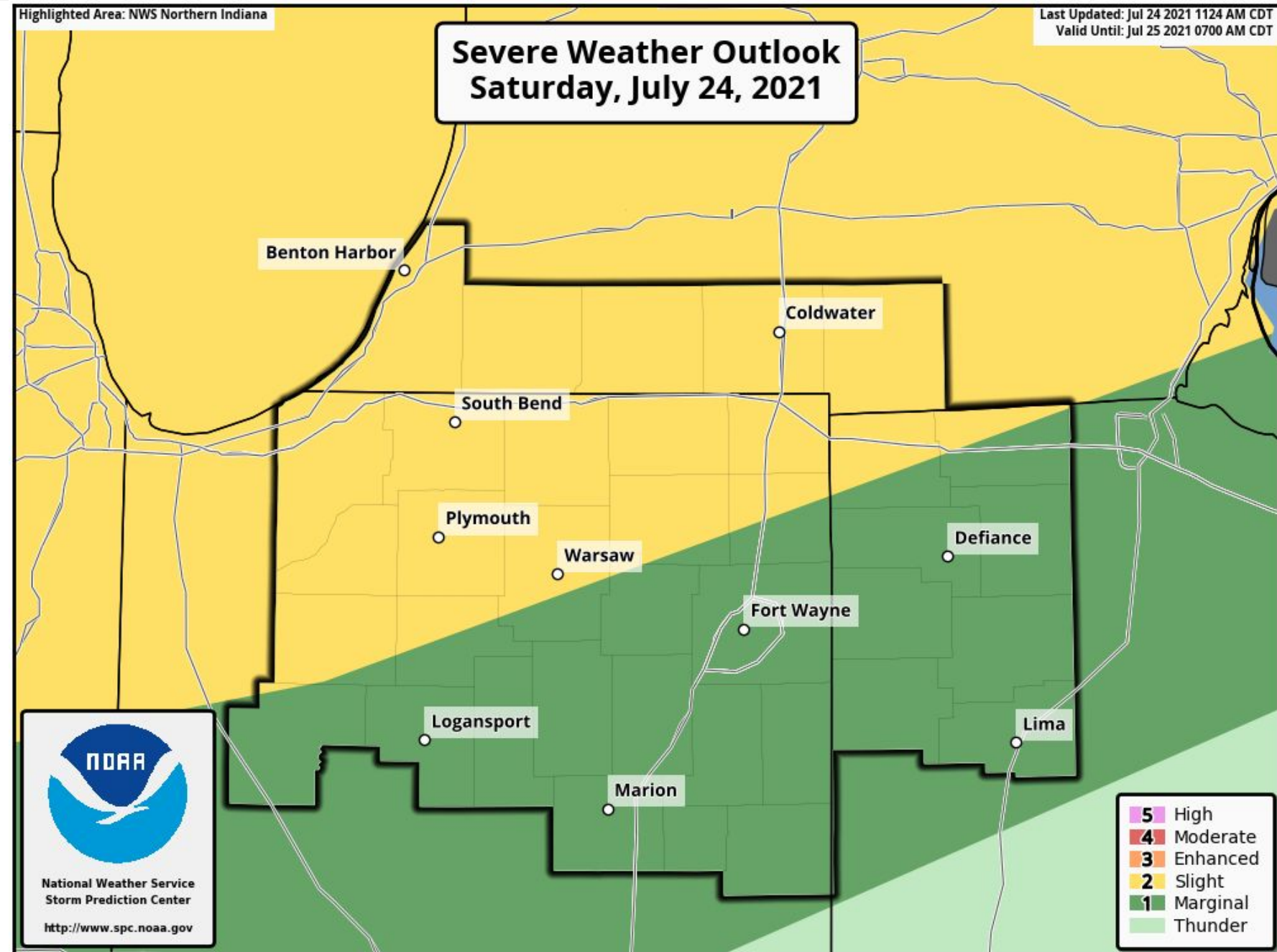
- Isolated storms expected through the afternoon, potentially increasing in coverage and intensity this evening
- Storms will move towards the east southeast at 30 mph
- The greatest threats will be damaging winds and heavy rain, mainly between 8 pm Saturday and 2 am Sunday

- SPC Slight Risk was expanded farther south

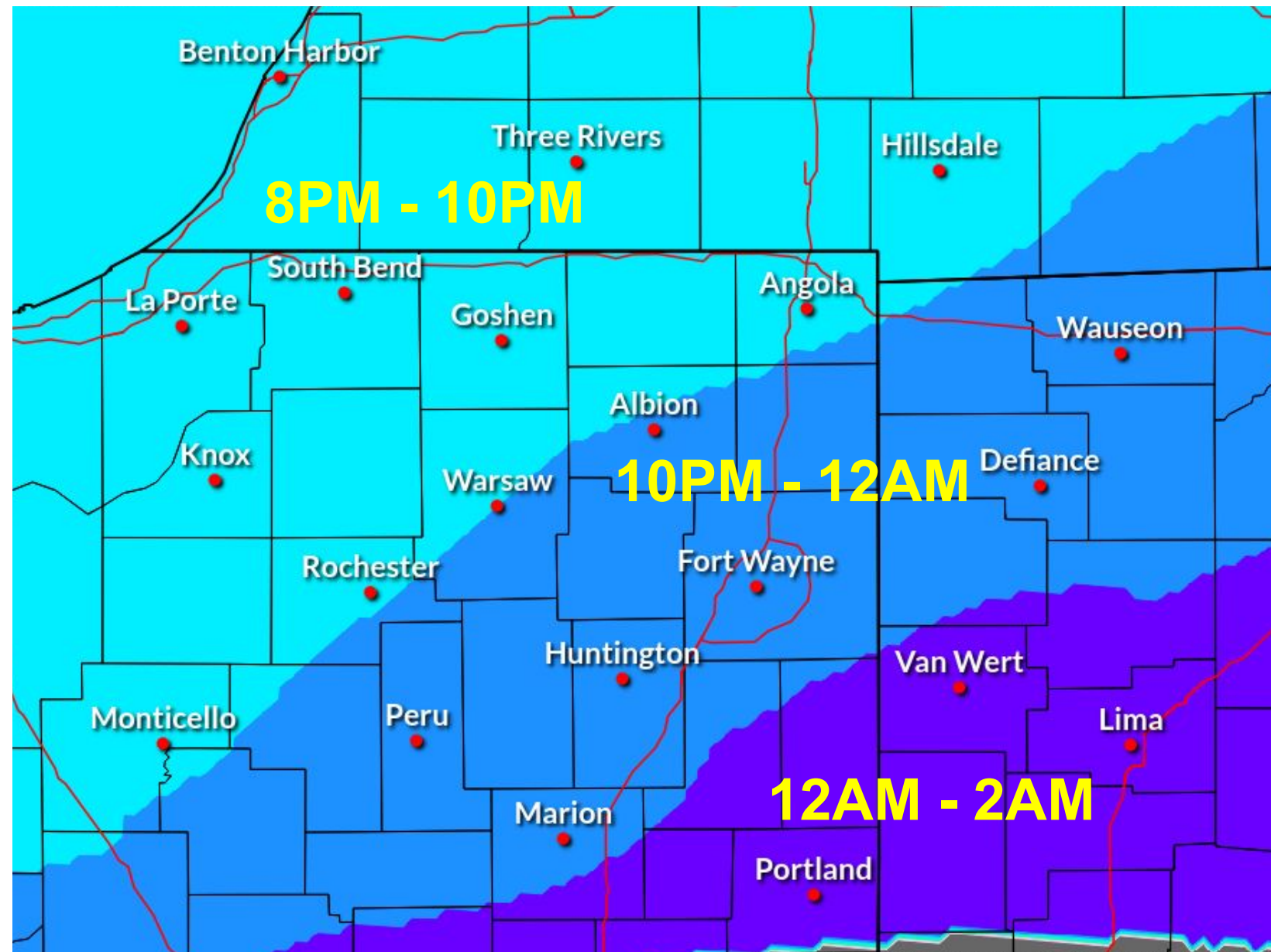

Greatest severe threat exists between 8 PM and Midnight EDT

## Timing



- Isolated thunderstorms will continue through the afternoon and early evening hours.
- A line of strong to severe storms is still expected to develop or move into NW Indiana and southern lower Michigan between 8 PM and 10 PM EDT
- This line will move south-southeast through the forecast area through the evening, potentially weakening as towards US-24 towards midnight.
- Most of the activity should be south of the area by 2 AM

## Overview

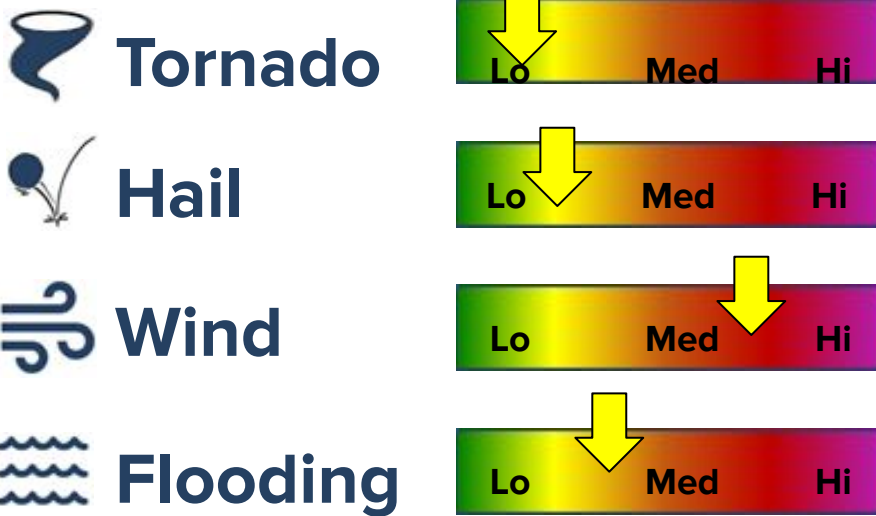
The main threats will be damaging wind and localized heavy rain. There is also a chance of hail. The tornado threat is low.
