

Key Messages

- → Flooding to continue this weekend into next week
 - Some rural/county roads remain flooded or impassable
 - Widespread minor flooding on rivers
 - Isolated moderate flooding possible
 - Ice jam flooding still possible
- → Strong system approaches early next week
 - Warmer temperatures will lead to snowmelt
 - Additional rainfall Monday into Tuesday
 - Prolonged flooding potential through next week





- Does NOT consider ice jams. Heavy ice on Salamonie and downstream \rightarrow portions of Wabash and Near Winamac on Tippecanoe






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Watch out for Ice Jams

Ice jams are accumulations of ice in a stream that obstruct flow

• Once formed, water can rise several feet in a matter of minutes
