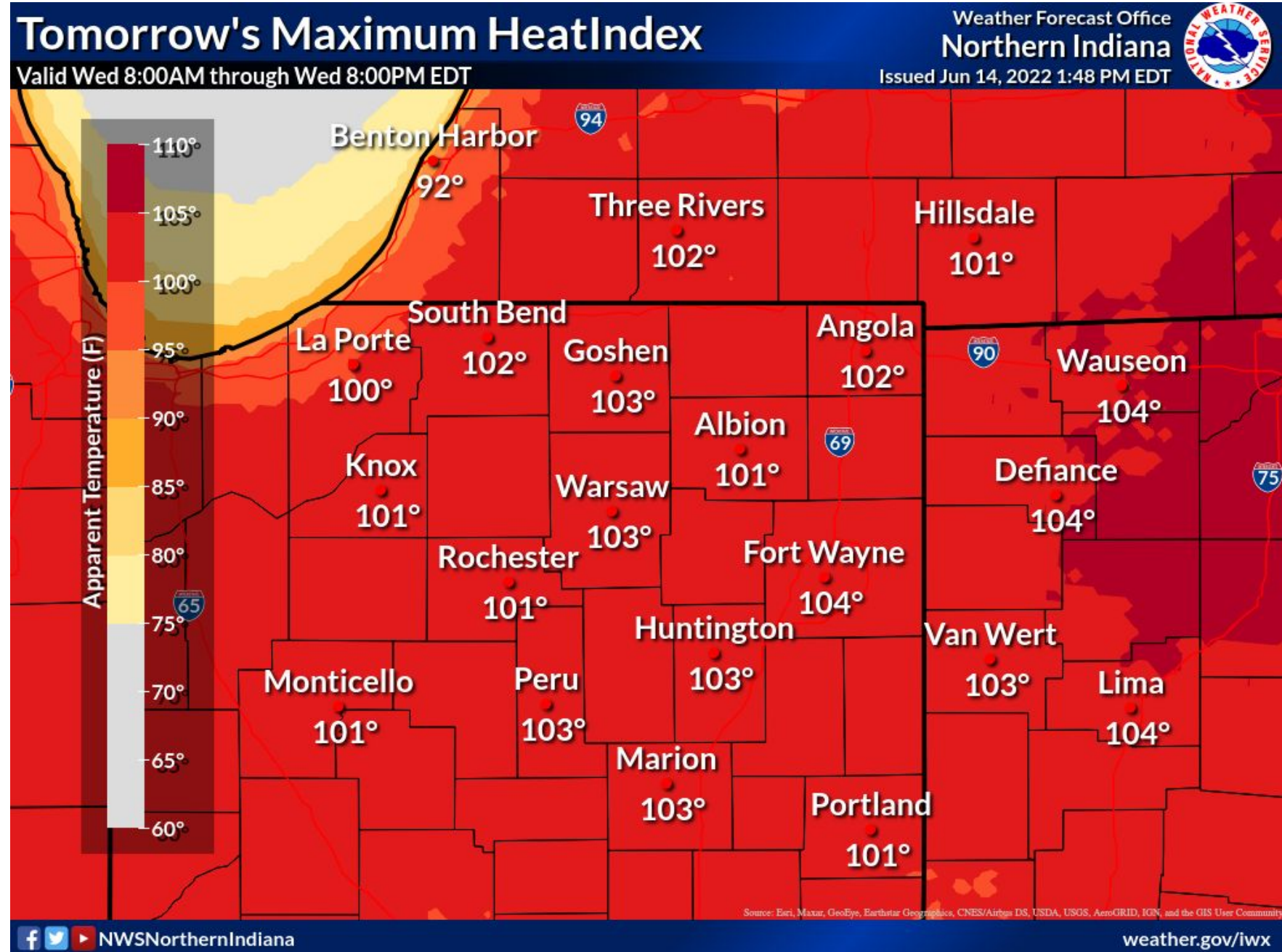

Overview

- Excessive heat and high humidity will continue on Wednesday 6/15. An Excessive Heat Warning remains in effect through Wednesday evening.
- Existing power outages from Monday night's storms may increase impacts.
- High heat index values of 100 to 110 degrees. Little relief at night. Cooler by Lake Michigan.
- Confidence is high.
- Outdoor activity should be minimized and air conditioned shelter should be used, drink plenty of fluids, and watch for signs of heat exhaustion/heat stroke

Key Messages

- Health and Medical - Medium - Potential for increased patient flow due to heat illnesses especially with existing power outages from Monday's storms
- Energy - Medium - Due to existing power outages from Monday night's storms and extra usage today and Wednesday due to high heat
- Food, Water, Shelter - Medium - Potential need for cooling centers and water distribution especially with existing power outages from Monday's storms
- Transportation & Communication - Low
